



# Uniform Policy

September 2015 – September 2017



## INTRODUCTION

We believe that the wearing of uniform encourages children to have a sense of belonging and of being part of a community. We have high ambitions for our children and having a smart appearance and attitude towards school is part of this. It is an outward expression of the school's identity and promotes a feeling of pride, equality and aspiration. In addition, we believe that the wearing of a 'uniform', as opposed to leisure wear contributes to helping children understand that they come to school to work and learn.

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal school hours.

## AIMS

Our policy on school uniform is based on the following aims: -

- To promote pride in their school and a sense of identity and belonging
- To ensure children develop good attitudes to learning and have high ambition.
- To promote the image of the school within the local area.
- To promote equality by eliminating competition amongst children in relation to what they wear
- To ensure that the uniform is simple, smart and reasonably priced.

We encourage all parents who send their children to our school to support the school uniform policy and make sure that every item is named.

## Uniform

Girls: -

- Black Skirt, pinafore or trousers
- Jade green school polo shirt with embroidered school logo
- Black school jumper or cardigan with embroidered school logo
- White or black socks or black tights
- Sensible, plain flat black shoes, NOT open toe shoes/sandals

Summer Alternatives: -

- Green and white gingham dress.
- White ankle socks,

Boys: -

- Black trousers or shorts.
- Jade green school polo shirt with embroidered school logo
- Black school jumper with embroidered school logo
- Grey socks or black ankle socks with shorts.
- Sensible plain black shoes.

All children need to wear a coat to school every day.



## **PE KIT**

All pupils should wear a school PE T shirt or a plain black t-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls for PE.

For Outdoor PE lessons pupils should wear black tracksuits.

Bikinis may not be worn for swimming lessons.

Watches and earrings must be removed for all PE, Games and swimming lessons.

## **JEWELLERY**

Pupils are not allowed to wear jewellery.

Pupils with pierced ears are permitted to wear small plain studs or sleepers only.

Inexpensive practical watches are permitted.

## **ORDERING SCHOOL UNIFORM**

School jumpers, cardigan, polo shirts and PE T-shirts and school badges are available from the school office.

The school has additional merchandise for sale such as book bags and PE bags embroidered with the school logo.
