FIFE AND RECORDER LESSONS – YEAR ONE CHILDREN

Would your child be interested in having music lessons?

Learning to play a musical instrument is good for brain development and helps children to hear and process sounds, which in turn can help with literacy.

After Easter we will be offering Year One children the opportunity to learn the Recorder or fife. Recorder and fife are foundations to learning larger instruments, such as the clarinet and flute.

Twenty minute lessons will be taught by an external music teacher, with the children being taught in small groups during school time. Instruments will be provided on loan from school.

Recorder or fife lessons will cost £2.00 per lesson (with a reduction to £1 per lesson for pupil premium pupils). Parents will need to commit to paying for a block of 11 lessons initially at a total cost of £22.00 (an £11 total cost for pupil premium pupils).

If you are interested in your child participating in Recorder or fife lessons, please complete and return the slip below, indicating which instrument you would like your child to learn, by Friday, 24th March and hand it into the school office.

Please do not send payment into school with this slip. You will receive a further letter confirming details of how and when the payment will need to be made prior to the lessons commencing.
